







## RECIPE: Peppermint Brittle

This peppermint brittle recipe is a Christmas time treat! This holiday confection is gobbled up quickly by guests and is so easy to make. The cool crunch of peppermint with creamy white chocolate is a divine combination.

## **Directions:**

Prep Time: 5 mins

Cook Time: 5 mins

Additional Time: 1hr

Total Time: 1 hr 10 mins

Servings: 36

Yield: 2 1/4 pounds

Ingredients

2 pounds white chocolate

30 small peppermint candy canes



## **STEPS:**

1.Line a large jellyroll pan with heavy-duty foil.

- 2. Place white chocolate in a microwave-safe bowl.
- 3. Microwave on medium power, stirring occasionally, until melted and smooth, 5 to 6 minutes.
- 4. Place candy canes in a plastic bag or between 2 pieces of waxed paper.
- 5. Using a mallet or rolling pin, break into small pieces. Stir candy pieces into melted white chocolate.
- 6. Spread white chocolate mixture evenly in the prepared pan.
- 7. Chill until set, about 1 hour.
- 8. Break into pieces by slamming the pan on the counter.
